The Caspian Sea is the largest sea in the world, its length is 1200 km, the water level is 361,000 cubic km, and the average depth is from 200 m to 1.5 km. The Aral Sea is smaller, its length is 480 km, its depth is 12-68 meters, its water level is 65,000, and its salt content is 11.3%. By 2000, the amount of all fish caught on the world scale has increased to more than 200 million tons, which corresponds to 950 million head of cattle, calculated on the basis of protein. Currently, 90% of the fish caught is in the ocean and sea, and only 10% is in freshwater. Out of 20,000 fish species, only 150 species are caught and considered economically effective. Fish caught in Central Asia makes up 5-7% of fish caught in the CIS countries. In our fresh water reservoirs, fish such as crucian carp, carp, crucian carp, crucian carp, crucian carp, white carp, and eel are caught in abundance. In 2000, 20,000 tons of fish were caught and consumed, which is 23-25% compared to meat. 700 different types of nutritious food are prepared from them.
