The atmosphere of relations in the family, the style of interaction between parents, between relatives, children significantly affect the formation of tolerance in the child.

Today, there is a need to educate a culture of tolerance from the very first days of study. But when its objects are children, the main burden and responsibility in working with them falls on the educational environment, on teachers. They need in this matter:

- ✓ Information on tolerance education
- ✓ Idea of possible means, technologies of education
- ✓ Tolerance is also necessary for the teacher himself

Tolerance is a professionally necessary personal quality of a teacher, dictated by the tasks, content and nature of his activity. The problem is complicated by the fact that this quality is associated with relationships not only with children (they are already very difficult in themselves), but also with adults. Perhaps the most difficult "site" for a teacher is tolerance in relations with parents. This environment has become increasingly demanding in recent years. Situations of confrontation, misunderstanding is not uncommon. But often parents are not free to choose an educational institution, children do not participate in the choice at all, and the teacher does not choose dads, mothers and children. Often you have to treat yourself, endure, in order to coexist.

To avoid and overcome the clash of authorities, it is necessary to restrain emotions, communicating with parents who are "difficult" for themselves, spare parental pride with the public and individual characteristics of children, and more fully inform parents about various aspects of the child's life in the team. This is how the basis of mutual tolerance is created.

In our kindergarten, as in many others in our time, children of different nationalities are brought up together. We try to create a favorable environment for everyone who, for one reason or another, came to our city and attends our kindergarten.

In the formation of tolerance among preschoolers, it is necessary to rely on game methods of education, since the game is the main activity of preschool children.

In order for the work on the education of tolerance among preschoolers to be fruitful, it is necessary to use a large range of events and different types of activities of preschoolers:

- Holding holidays and other mass events in order to get children acquainted with the culture and traditions of their people and peoples of the world;
- Theatrical activity of preschoolers on the subjects, which are based on fairy tales of the peoples of the world;



- Russian folk moving games, games of the peoples of the world;
- Acquaintance of children with the traditions of the peoples of different countries;
- Meeting with parents of other nationalities and stories about their culture, traditions;
- Acquaintance with the work of the peoples of the world;
- Acquaintance with the tales of the peoples of the world;
- Organization of joint activities of parents and children.

Most of the issues of raising tolerance in children in preschool are devoted to the joint activities of the teacher and children. We begin to introduce children to the folklore of the peoples of the countries of the world. In cognitive activity, there is an acquaintance with the geographical location of the state, the peculiarities of nature, climate, ethnographic and cultural characteristics of different peoples. Productive activity is aimed at introducing and teaching preschoolers to traditional national types of art: origami, embroidery, painting in the batik technique, painting wooden and plaster products, painting exotic landscapes, sculpting animals, etc. During games with dolls, pupils can get acquainted with national costumes or their details (kimono, sari, moccasins, etc.), with skin color and pronounced facial features characteristic of another nationality, in games with building material - with the peculiarities of building dwellings of different peoples. Moving folk games also give children an idea of the peculiarities of a particular nation, lifestyle, culture.

From all of the above, we can conclude that it is necessary to start forming tolerance in children as early as possible, since the earlier work is started, the higher the results in raising children. The work should be systematic and systematic, built taking into account the age and individual characteristics of children. The material is interesting and diverse, using innovative technologies and techniques.

The child will be open to the world and tolerant if in his family he will feel kindness and respect for each other, understanding and calmness from birth.

To be tolerant is to perceive the world in all wealth and diversity. Teach children to be just that, and then they will have no barriers to communication.

Had you not formed any sketch



in your imagination, such feeling of disliking wouldn't have been developed. So, yes, the benefit of the doubt or simply saying you don't about him/her enable you to explore a different soul that doesn't fit into your conventional box of thought.

In recent years we have witnessed several gut-wrenching riots in our society. Most of those got its needed provocation by incendiary social media posts. Such posts being deliberately done by an individual to hurt sentiments but we being a totally intolerant society like to respond to such derogatory posts with utmost vehemence! A mob come on the street, set public transports and cop vehicles on fire and like to feel an assuagement for their hurt feelings. So much lack of self-questioning is connected with these riots.
